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Project Summary

Background

This project is an opportunity to meet our the needs of our institution' in terms of staff professional development, school's digital strategy and pupils' online safety. Our teachers needs to improve their digital skills in order to be able to adapt their teaching style to the actual demands of society. Our school needs to take further steps for a successful digital transformation while respecting the safety of our students. Through the Erasmus + program, we have identified training opportunities in the field of digitization and Internet safety. This will benefit our institution by its European dimension and by getting our school involved in the vast international network in the field of school education.

Objectives

By implementing this project we want to increase the quality of education provided by digitizing our school, developing the digital skills of teachers and integrating ICTS in teaching. We want to promote a responsible behavior of our school community in the online environment, to prevent cyberbullying and to ensure a safe climate conducive to education. Last but not least, increasing the school's capacity for European cooperation in the field of education would benefit our institution by promoting common European values.

Activities

To achieve the objectives, the following were designed:

PREMOBILITY ACTIVITIES: promoting the project Establishing the implementation team; Selection of participants, pedagogical, linguistic and cultural training, finalization of the monitoring and evaluation plan, registration in the Mobility Tool + database, signing of contracts arranging the Erasmus + Panel;

MOBILITY FLOWS: participation of 10 teachers in 2 training courses for the development of digital skills and digital security, 5 teachers in a job-shadowing activity for the development of digital strategy and prevention of cyberbullying, 5 students in group mobility on the topic of cyberbullying

POSTMOBILITY ACTIVITIES: information sessions in the Teachers' Council, methodical commissions, pedagogical circles; workshops with students, demonstration activities, interview with the Europe Direct Botosani Center, elaboration of a guide of good practices, eTwinning cooperation activities, organization of a symposium.

Impact

the project will lead to the following results: 15 teachers trained in 3 European courses / activities to meet the needs of the school; 1 guide to good practice in the field of online security and cyberbullying, 3 workshops; , an interview, 1 symposium organized on the fight against cyberbullying, 3 eTwinning cooperation activities, digital, linguistic and intercultural skills developed by the participating teachers.

Long-term benefits: The good practice guide and the symposium will ensure the sustainability of skills and acquisitions and will provide teachers in the institutions involved with a real exchange of experience. The 3 eTwinning activities and communication with teachers from other countries will ensure relationships at European level. These links will be a starting point for other Erasmus collaborations / projects

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
